# How to Access the NIJ subscription to the ASTM International Standard and Test Method Portal

Register through the National Law Enforcement and Corrections Technology Center by sending an email to <u>asknlectc@justnet.org</u>.

Send this email from a valid address demonstrating that you are a current, active member of a federal, state or local law enforcement/first responder, corrections or forensics agency. **Do not use a personal email address (e.g., Gmail, Yahoo).** 

Include "Request access to NIJ/ASTM Standards Portal" in the subject line.

Once your agency email address has been confirmed, you will receive login credentials.

# Once registered, go to the JustNet access ASTM url, which will redirect you to the ASTM Compass website.

When you see the Department of Justice seal in the top right hand corner, you know you have been registered for the correct access.
