Disclaimer

Individuals using these tabulations are cautioned against drawing conclusions by making direct comparisons between grantees. The National Institute of Justice (NIJ) collects these data through the DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction (CEBR) Program through the Office of Justice Programs' (OJP) Performance Measurement Tool (PMT).

General Comment

This table provides the most recent aggregations and results provided by the grantees during their last data submission period. Aggregated measures such as (D.) Number of cases analyzed, (E.) CODIS uploads, and (F.) CODIS hits incorporated data beginning in January 1, 2016 to June 30, 2018. Also, measures (A.) Average number of forensic biology/DNA samples analyzed per analyst per month, (B.) Average number of days between the submission of a request for forensic biology/DNA analysis to the laboratory and the delivery of the test results, and (C.) Backlogged forensic biology/DNA cases were compiled based on each grantee's last submission period of grant activity. Lastly, please note that a subset of grantees had award extensions past their standard two-year performance period.

Methodology

The data used in creating this table was from law enforcement agencies submitting data into OJP PMT every six months from January 1, 2016 to June 30, 2018. If NIJ determines certain variables have created unusual fluctuations in the data, those data are excluded from the tabulations.
