The collection of such samples is to be taken by a physician or nurse duly licensed by the State of New Jersey, or a law enforcement officer, using accepted medical procedures, at a time convenient to both but without unnecessary delay. The sample will be analyzed by the NJ State Police Laboratory, or other laboratory, and the results may be retained and used for any criminal justice purpose.

Further, by signing this consent form, I release from any liability or responsibility, as a result of the sample collection, the County of Essex, the Essex County Prosecutor's Office, and its investigators, _____ Police Department and its officers and any duly licensed physician or nurse chosen by the Essex County Prosecutor's Office to perform the above mentioned procedure. This written permission is being given by me voluntarily and without threats or promises of any kind.
