### **Solicitation Purpose & Goals**

Increase knowledge of jails in the U.S.

Bolster development of policy and practices to improve outcomes for incarcerated persons, their communities, and jail personnel



### **Solicitation Focus Areas**

 1: Improving Reentry Outcomes and Minimizing the Impact of Jail Incarceration on Justice-involved Individuals and Their Communities

2: Optimizing Workforce Development

3: Enhancing Corrections Practices



### **Expected Deliverables**

- Standard grant reporting requirements
  - Semi-annual research performance progress reports
  - Quarterly financial reports
- 2. Final Research Report
- 3. Associated data sets or files
- 4. Scholarly products



### **Application Submission**

- Critical Application Elements:
  - Program Narrative
  - Budget Web-Based Form (budget details and narrative)
  - Curriculum vitae or resume for Key Personnel

### Required Forms:

- SF-424
- SF-LLL



### **Two-Step Application Submission Protocol**

#### 1. Grants.gov

- Submit SF-424 and SF-LLL forms ONLY
- Deadline: *May 4, 2023*
- Register at <u>https://www.grants.gov/web/grants/register.html</u>

#### 2. JustGrants

- Submit the FULL application, including all attachments
- Deadline: *May 18, 2023*
- Register at <u>https://justicegrants.usdoj.gov/getting-started</u>



### **Application Review Process**

- Basic Minimum Requirement Determination
- External Expert Review
  - Technical and practitioner reviewers
  - Independent scores and comments
- Internal Review
  - NIJ science staff, NIJ leadership and other federal subject matter experts

All funding decisions are made at the discretion of the NIJ Director



### **Common Critiques Raised During Peer Review Process**

#### Statement of the Problem

- Fails to identify gaps in the current literature or understanding of current research
- Literature review is insufficient
- Scope of the proposed research is extremely limited or too ambitious

#### **Research Design**

- Overall strategy is not well articulated
- Design/methods approach does not logically flow/unclear
- Proposed sample size is not supported by a power analysis
- Project is not feasible



### **Common Critiques Raised During Peer Review Process**

#### Capabilities and Competencies

- Proposed staff does not demonstrate familiarity or proficiency with the proposed methods
- Project team does not include necessary and appropriate subject matter experts.

#### **Potential Impact**

- Dissemination plan lacks specificity and/or is not innovative
- No plan for reaching nonacademic audiences



### Tips

- Proposals should be
  - Well-written
  - Innovative
  - Timely
  - Rigorous and well-designed
  - Feasible
  - Impactful
- Research/Evaluation Independence
- Letters of Support



### What Will **NOT** be Funded

- Unresponsive applications
- Duplicative/similar research
- Applications to purchase equipment/materials/supplies, etc.
- Training/direct services unrelated to project



### FAQs

- Award amount + period of performance
- Specify focus area
- Timing of award and non-award notifications
- Foreign entities / subrecipients / co-investigators
- Filling and submitting forms / IRB / HSP / New Investigator
